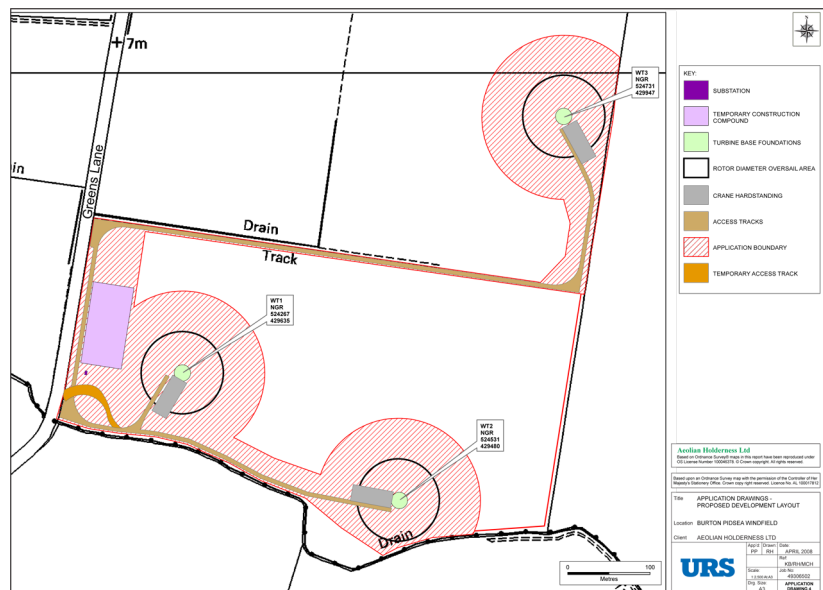

Burton Pidsea is a village located to the north-east of Kingston upon Hull, in the East Riding of Yorkshire. Aeolian Holderness proposed a wind field comprising 3 turbines constructed on farm land to the south of Burton Pidsea.

CgMs are employed as the project's archaeological consultants, preparing the Archaeological/Cultural Heritage Chapter for the Environmental Statement and managing the Archaeological Evaluation to discharge the planning conditions.

The site of the development lies within a classic wetland landscape which has seen intensive human activity for much of the last 10,000 years. Roos Carr (situated to the east of the application area) is a good example of the quality of wetland preservation that may exist in areas like this, being the location for the discovery of the internationally famous Late Bronze Age / Early Iron Age Roos Carr carved wooden figures and model boat.
