CgMs provided to National Grid an external consents officer, whose role it was to secure the necessary permissions for the surface elements associated with a proposed 400kV cable tunnel between Hurst, in the London Borough of Bexley and Eltham, in the London Borough of Greenwich. These elements included :

- a head house and modifications to access arrangements on operational land at Hurst;
- a head house within Danson Park, a registered park and garden;
- a head house, super grid transformer and ancillary equipment at Eltham.

The role involved :

- managing the consents process;
- preparation of planning supporting statements and design and access statements;
- managing environmental consultants to produce Environmental Reports for the schemes and supporting information for planning applications;
- liaison with the project team;
- negotiation with statutory bodies, including the local planning authorities and English Heritage;
- attendance at public consultation events and liaison with local residents.
