CgMs's Historic Buildings Team were involved in providing support, over a long period, to a scheme to update and reconfigure Sunbury Court, a Grade II* listed mansion house that the Salvation Army now use as a conference centre. Having not been upgraded for a number of years, Sunbury Court had become rather dated, with a number of internal spaces and external additions detracting from the building's significance. Working closely with the rest of the design team, CgMs undertook a detailed room-by-room appraisal of the whole site, identifying those spaces and details that should be retained, and others that could be altered. Engaging in detailed discussions with stakeholders, including Spelthorne Borough Council and English Heritage, the team were able to successfully negotiate listed building consent and planning permission for the internal reconfiguration and upgrade of the building, the addition of a contemporary modern addition, and extensive landscaping works.



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
