Network Rail intends to submit an application to the Infrastructure Planning Commission for an order granting development consent for the construction of a new grade separated junction at the Norton Bridge Junction on the West Coast Main Line as part of the Stafford Area Improvements.

The site is approximately 6 km in length and is located at Norton Bridge in Staffordshire, 10 km to the north-west of Stafford and 2 km west of the M6 motorway.

CgMs have recently completed a Heritage Assessment of the site and are undertaking the monitoring of Ground Investigation Works along the length of the route alignment.

We are also advising on the most appropriate archaeological evaluation strategy for the site and assessing the environmental impact of the development upon heritage assets.



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
